

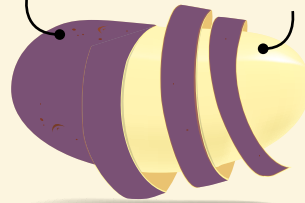

DESCRIPTION

Frivol is a medium-early variety, with purple skin and cream flesh. It produces elongated tubers with shallow eyes.

The variety is very hardy, with low sensitivity to viruses.

The dry matter is about 22%. Conservation is Good without sugaring conservation.

Colour after frying is very clear and the industrial yield is excellent.
